Young Robot Builders Investigate Climate Connections

The 8th annual Los Altos Robotics FIRST LEGO League program starts Sep 5th, 2008 with the worldwide challenge kick-off of **CLIMATE CONNECTIONS**. **FLL** introduces students in grades 4 to age 14 to the wonders of engineering, science, math, and technology in a fun and engaging way.

FLL pairs an academic challenge with a sports-like playing field where children create autonomous robots. Each fall, teams of 4-6 players have 8 weeks to design, construct, program, and test their robots. They compete in fun and exciting tournaments, running robots in time trials and demonstrating technology creativity.

Los Altos Robotics hosts the Los Altos FLL Competition, a qualifying event for the Northern California state tournament. Last year, 26 Los Altos area teams with over 140 local students participated. Cost per player ranges from \$125 to \$160. Over 9000 teams, with more than 100,000 players will be compete in similar tournaments around the world.
